on Green Avenue in the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at corner of lot of James Moore and Peretta Mekins, running thence with Greene Avenue S. 26-45 W. 50 feet to corner of Williams lot; thence S. 62-10 E. 179.8 feet to Crosskeys Alley; thence with said Alley N. 26-35 E. 50 feet to Moore and Mekins corner; thence with Moore and Mekins lot N. 62-10 W. 178.75 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed to William Donald, Sr. by deed dated December 22, 1922, by E.
