(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
W. H. Howard and his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
lying on the South side of the Tugalo Road, near the Highland Baptist Church and West from same,
having the following courses and distances:

Beginning on a stone, the Northwestern corner of said tract, and runs thence S. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$
W. 3.33 chains to a stone; thence S. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 6.16 chains to a stone; thence N. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.33 chains
to a stone; thence N. 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.16 chains to the beginning corner, containing Two (2) acres, more
or less, and being the identical tract of land on which the Highland Schoolhouse was formerly
located.
