Beginning at a point on Southeast corner of Stone Avenue and Wilton Street, and running thence with Wilton Street S. $5\frac{1}{2}$ W. 150 feet to a pin on Wilton Street; thence S. 87 E. 50 feet to a pin; thence N. $5\frac{1}{2}$ E. 150 feet to Stone Avenue; thence with Stone Avenue N. $84\frac{1}{2}$ W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
