

GENERAL PERMIT

Received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company, Inc., One Dollar in consideration of which we hereby grant unto said Company, its associated and allied companies, their respective successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of Telephone and Telegraph, and for the general transmission of intelligence, consisting of such poles, wires, cables, conduits, guys, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as the grantee may from time to time require, upon, over and/or under the property which we own in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina and upon, along and/or under the roads, streets, or highways adjoining the said property, and the right to permit the attachment of and/or carry in conduit wires and cables of any other company or person, and with the further right to trim and cut trees so as to clear and keep cleared said Company's plant; said sum being received in full payment for the rights herein given.

This grant relates to all that property of the grantor located on or near the old Buncombe road (Highway No. 25) and upon which the main plant and village of the grantor are situated.

It is the intent of this permit to authorize and grant to the grantee, the right and privilege to erect and maintain lines and other equipment for the servicing of the houses and buildings in the aforementioned village of the grantor. Such rights and privileges shall not be exhausted by the partial use, but shall continue, and the grantee may from time to time exercise the privileges herein granted, provided that before actually erecting any such lines, the approval of the proposed layout, including the location of line, poles and other facilities of an executive officer of the grantor shall be secured and such approval of the print of the proposed construction being sufficient evidence thereof.
