Cooper, Mrs. Willena Gray, and Mrs. Mary Renners as Trustees for the Apostolic Faith, and their successors and assigns

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot 100 of Conestee as shown by a Plat thereof, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated December, 1943, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "K" at Page 276, said lot having such metes and bounds and courses and distances as are shown on said plat.

This deed is made subject to the easements, reservations, and limitations that are set forth in the deed of the grantors herein to Blackinton Mills, Inc., recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in deeds Vol. 288, Page 296.

This property is deeded to the Trustees hereinabove named for use as a Church as hereinabove stated and it is to be used for no other purpose, except upon a resolution by the duly constituted governing board of said Church and then it may be sold or traded for other property to be used for such Church.
