TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, Bessie Q. Wood, in her own right, and as Administratrix of the Estate of I. M. Wood, deceased

on or about the 7th day of July in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty-seven exhibited her complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against T. J. Wood, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 21st of Dec. 1945 ~~xxxx~~ and 29th of April, 1946, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a Decree

of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to T. J. Wood and Matt Wood

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgement Roll No. E-10572)

NOW, THEREFORE, Know All Men by These Presents, That I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$2100.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said

T. J. Wood and Matt Wood

"All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, and containing 51 acres, more or less, as shown on plat of the property of I. M. Wood Estate, made by H. S. Brockman, surveyor, March 16, 1946, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P", Page 35, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds and courses and distances to-wit:

BEGINNING at a birch stump on the northeastern side of the Enoree River and in line of the 44.72 acre tract of the I. M. Wood Estate and running thence N. 72.15 E. 24.40 chains to a point in or near the center of Princess Creek; thence along the meanderings of said creek as the line S. 20 E. to the intersection of said creek and Enoree River; thence along the meanderings of Enoree River as a line (new run) to the point of beginning."

The grantees are to pay all taxes on the above property beginning with the year 1946.
