(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Belle T. Vaughn, her Heirs and Assigns, Forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the West side of Fifth Avenue, in Section No. 2 of Judson Mills Village in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 56, as shown on a Plat of Section No. 2 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in November, 1939, which Plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at Page 25, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Fifth Avenue, joint corner of Lots Nos. 56 and 57, said pin being 160.6 feet North from the Northwest corner of the intersection of Fifth Avenue and Sixth Street and running thence with the line of Lot No. 57, N. 83-53 W. 300.9 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-16 W. 83.3 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 55, S. 83-53 E. 324.3 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Fifth Avenue; thence with the West side of Fifth Avenue, S. 6-07 W. 80 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of Judson Mills, dated December 30, 1939, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 217, Page 210.

The Grantee agrees to pay 1946 taxes on the above property.
