HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said C. S. Major and Amelia K. Major;

All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 4 acres, 2 roods, and 24 poles,
situated in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Austin Township, on the
Waters of Reedy River, the same more or less:

Beginning at a rock 3xnm, and thence S. 18 E. 10.35 chains to a stake 3xnm in the old road
leading from McDaniels to Lenderman's Ford on Reedy River; thence along said road, S. 53 W. 4.50
chains to a bend in said road; thence S. 37 3/4 W. 2.44 chains along said road to a bend in said
road; thence S. 45 W. 1.66 chains to a small pine on said road; thence N. 6 1/2 E. 15.12 chains;
thence N. 78 1/2 E. 1.46 chains to the beginning corner.
