POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT: That I, E. P. Livingston of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, do hereby constitute and appoint Thomas Anderson, residing at

Greenville County and State aforesaid, my true and lawful attorney for me and in my name, place, and stead to:

- (1) Assume all my duties and obligations and to perform all functions now performed by me as a member of the partnership doing business as the Southern Products Company.
- (2) Collect all monies that are presented in the normal course of business due and payable to the Southern Products Company which, if I were in person present, would be paid to me; and upon the collection of said monies, to present them to the proper member of the partnership.

- (4) Supervise the manufacture and packing and all matters incident thereto of any and all products now manufactured by the Southern Products Company.
- (5) Pass on any matter of policy of the operation of the said partnership, the Southern Products Company, which arises in the normal course of business of said firm.
- (6) Do all things which I would have done if I were in person present which arise out of and in the normal course of said partnership.

And I, the said E. P. Livingston, do hereby ratify and confirm all acts whatsoever that my said attorney in fact shall do or cause to be done by virtue of this Power of Attorney.

This power of Attorney to remain in full force & effect until cancelled & revoked by me in writing.
