TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

GRANT OF EASEMENT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY.

As a part of the consideration hereof, the said Semco, Inc. agrees that the grantor herein and her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, shall have the right to one tap on said water line and sewer line at any point along the line thereof.
