TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, COUNTY OF GREEN VILLE.

LEASE

THIS INDENTURE made and entered into this 30th day of November, 1946, by and between PAUL J. ŒLAND, doing business at Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Lessor, and KOOLVENT METAL AWNING CO., a corporation, doing business at Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Lessee,

WITNESSETH:

That for and in consideration of the premises, payments, covenants and agreements hereinafter set forth, by each of the parties to be respectively kept and performed, the Lessor does hereby lease, demise and let unto the Lessee the real property located just north of the Camp Road near its intersection with North Main Street on the North side of Simpson Drive, fronting on Simpson Drive 70.4 feet and being shown as Lot 14 on plat of Paul J. Celand property made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, October 1946, recorded in Plat Book "P", page 95 and running back to the railway sidetrack, on which a one-story warehouse is to be erected by the Lessor as hereinafter provided, with all improvements to be erected thereon.

AISO the right to use jointly with Oeland-Simpson Lumber Company that platform lying along said railway siding, a portion of which is located on other property of said Paul J. Oeland.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said demised premises to the Lessee for a term of five (5) years from the 1st day of December, 1946, to the 30th day of November, 1951, at an annual rental in the amount hereinafter provided.

And the said parties do hereby covenant and agree with each other as follows:

1. The lessor shall promptly, at his own cost and expense, construct on said demised premises a one-story warehouse to contain approximately 4,200 square feet of space, all in accordance with the blueprints, plans and specifications annexed hereto and made a part hereof.

Said building shall be constructed in accordance with the rulings, regulations and orders of Governmental, State, Municipal and administrative departments having jurisdiction thereof and shall be completed and ready for occupancy not later than December 1, 1946, delays due to circumstances beyond the control of the Lessor excepted; provided, however, that no rent shall be due and payable by the Lessee until the aforesaid building is fully completed.

- 2. The Lessee shall pay an annual rental of Fifteen Hundred (\$1,500.00) Dollars payable in equal monthly installments of One Hundred Twen ty-five (\$125.00) Dollars each, in advance on the first day of each and every month during the term hereof.
- The Lessor shall, during the term hereof, at his own cost and expense, keep the demised premises, exterior and interior, in good order and repair, provided that the portions in need of repair do not at any time exceed a "partial destruction" as hereinafter defined and provided further that any damage to said premises caused by the negligence of the Lessee (except damage resulting from fire) shall be promptly repaired by the Lessee at its own cost and expense, and in the event of its failure or refusal so to do, the Lessor shall have the right to make the repairs at the expense of the Lessee, and the cost thereof shall be added to and collectible with the next subsequently accruing installment of rent payable hereunder. In the event of the failure of the Lessor to make repairs required by him to be made as aforesaid, the Lessee shall have the right to make such repairs and deduct the cost thereof from the next subsequently accruing installment or installments of rent payable hereunder, or, at the option of the Lessee, and upon ten days' written notice to the Lessor, this lease shall terminate and
