All my right, title and interest in and to any and all property both real and personal belonging to the estate of Mariah Thompson, including any and all interest which I may have or become entitled to in that certain house and lot on Marsailles Avenue located in Ward 1 of the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, being the same property heretofore conveyed by Harriet McMahan to Mariah Thompson by deed dated January 26, 1888, recorded in Vol. TT, Page 757, and deed dated November 23, 1889, recorded in Vol. VV, page 345, RMC Office for Greenville County; also that certain tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, State and County aforesaid containing 5 1/2 acres, more or less, conveyed by W.B. Thompson, Mamie Poole and W. H. Avery to Mariah Thompson by deed dated May 14, 1913 and recorded in Vol. 18, at page 293, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and also that certain tract of land in Paris Mountain Township, State and County aforesaid conveyed by J. W. Gray to Mariah Thompson by deed dated March 4, 1911, being known as Tract No. 11 on plat of survey of lands of the estate of Gabriel Thompson containing 24 1/2 acres, more or less, said deed having been recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 159, at page 346.
