DEED OF CORRECTION.

WHEREAS, under date of Jan. 17, 1913, J. B. Rasor conveyed to J. M. Wood, Jr., a certain lot of land in City View, described in said deed as being on the Southeast corner of Summitt and Y. M. C. A. Streets; and

WHEREAS, the said lot of land should have been described as being on the Southwest corner of Summitt and Y. M. C. A. Streets; and

WHEREAS, under date of Nov. 2, 1937, the said J. B. Rasor departed this life testate leaving the remainder of his estate to John B. Rasor, Jr., and

WHEREAS, it is now desired that the above stated deed be corrected;  
NOW, THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, John B. Rasor, Jr.

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and in order to correct description of property,

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to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Arthur Dacus,

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Arthur Dacus, his heirs and assigns forever,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in School District 8-AA, shown on County Black Book at page 136, Block 13, Lot No. 1; also shown on plat of City View Land Company, made by F. G. Rogers, Engineer, June, 1909, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "A", at page 327, as Lot No. one (1), Block "B", at the Southwest corner of the intersection of Y. M. C. A. and Summitt Streets, having a frontage of fifty (50) feet on Y. M. C. A. Street and running back in parallel lines one hundred and fifty (150) feet, more or less; and being the same lot of land conveyed to J. B. Rasor by T. T. Goldsmith and Arthur S. Agnew by their deed dated June 24th, 1911, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book No. 13, at page 190.
