TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

It is understood and agreed that the Lessees will not assign this lease or sublet the premises or any portion thereof without the written consent of the Lessor.

It is understood and agreed that such business as Lessees may operate upon said premises shall be operated in such manner as not to constitute a nuisance.
