of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 7 as shown on plat of  
Tract No. 2 of the Estate of John B. Marshall, made by Dalton & Neves,  
October, 1939, said plat recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County in Plat Book J, pages 132 and 133, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of the White Horse Road, 655  
feet from the intersection of the said White Horse Road with the Easley  
Bridge Road, said point being the joint front corner of lots 6 and 7  
and running thence with said White Horse Road S. 9-30 W. 80 feet to  
joint front corner of lots 7 and 8; thence with the common line of Lots  
7 and 8, N. 80-30 W. 210 feet to an iron pin, the joint rear corner of  
Lots 7 and 8; thence in a northeasterly direction 85.3 feet to an iron  
pin, the joint rear corner of Lots 6 and 7; thence along the common  
line of lots 6 and 7 S. 80-30 E. 180.2 feet to an iron pin on the west  
side of the White Horse Road, the beginning corner.
