

County, State of South Carolina known and designated as Lot #8, Section "C" of a subdivision known as Parkvale, as appears from a plat of Dalton & Neves, dated, July 1940, recorded in the R.M.C.Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "K" on page 54, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin corner of Bennett Street/and a 41 foot street known
