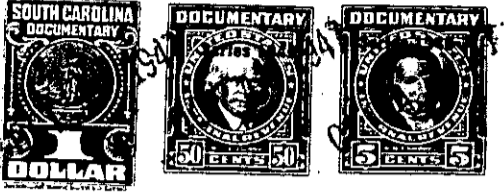

County, State of South Carolina, just off the New Buncombe Road about three miles from Greenville County Court House, being known and designated as a part of tract No. 4 of property of Union Central Life Insurance Company, on plat made by Dalton and Neeves, Engineers, April 1937, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance, State and County aforesaid in plat book No. 1 at pages 69 and 70 and being designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of property of A.
