all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oneal Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, and in the Village of Neal on the East side of
the Rutherford Road, bounded on the north by S. M. Forrester, on the
East by lands of Goodlet, and on the South by lands of Few and Beachem,
known as the gin lot, and others, and on the West by the said Ruther-
ford Road leading from Oneal to Berry's Mill, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake in center of the Rutherford Road, common corners
of the tract hereinafter described, and the Few and Beachem lot, and
running thence N. 70-20 E. 118 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 92.20 E.
85 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 45.30 E. 2:0 feet to a stake near
the southwest side of the County road; thence N. 85-30 E. 143.8 feet
to an iron pin; thence N. 5.07 E. 239 feet to an iron pin; thence N.
80.45 W., along the Forrester line, 455.5 feet to a stake in the center
of the Rutherford Road, said road leading from Oneal to Berry's Mill;
thence S. 14.15 W. 221 feet to the point of beginning, and containing
2.30 acres, more or less, and being more fully described by plat
prepared by H. S. Brockman, June 4, 1946, hereto attached and made
a part hereof, and designated as Lot No. 5.
