Know all Men by these Presents, That I, William B. Ducker, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of Seventy-Four Hundred, Sixty and No/100 - - - Dollars

to me paid by Leon Lewis Clark

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leon Lewis Clark, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the Southeast side of the Paris Mountain Road, and being known and designated as Lot No. 3 of a subdivision known as Paris Piney Park, as shown on plat thereof made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engr., in June, 1926 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at pages 19 and 20, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Paris Mountain Road at the corner of Lot No. 4, which point is 50 feet Southwest of the intersection of Orlando Avenue, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 4, S. 24-20 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 65-40 W. 50 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 2; thence along the line of that lot, N. 24-20 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Paris Mountain Road; thence along the line of said Paris Mountain Road, N. 65-40 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

The grantee is to pay taxes for 1947.
