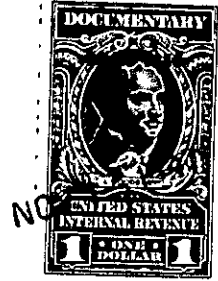
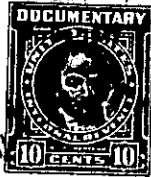
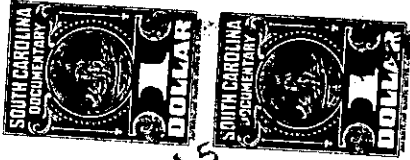

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being  
on the North side of Gatling Avenue near the City of Greenville, in  
the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as  
Lot 237 on plat of Augusta Road Ranches made by Dalton and Neves,  
Engineers, revised April 1942, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for  
Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "M", page 47 and  
having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Gatling Avenue at  
joint front corner of Lots 236 and 237 and running thence with the  
line of Lot 236 N. 0-13 W. 140 feet to an iron pin; thence with the  
rear line of Lot 257 S. 89-47 W. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence with
