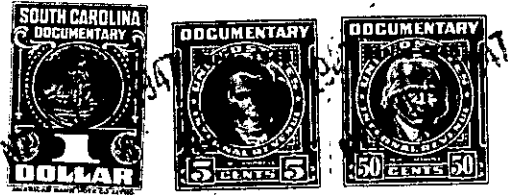

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, T. M. Crain,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Fifteen and no/100 -  
Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Walter A. Lynn

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Walter A. Lynn, and his Heirs and

Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, lying on the North side of the surfaced road  
that leads from Lenoah School to Camp Creek, and near said school  
building, and being the greater portion of Tract No. 12 on a plat of  
the W. W. Davis Estate, by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated January  
23, 1947, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a stake on the North edge of said road, joint corner  
of Tracts Nos. 12 and 13, and running with line of Tract No. 13, N.  
38.45 E. 1520 feet to a stake on line of Tract No. 1; thence with No.  
1, S. 86.30 E. 350 feet to a stake, corner Tract No. 2; thence S.  
41 W. 1740 feet to a stake on North side of said road; thence with  
North edge of road, 187 feet to the beginning corner; less therefrom  
one-half acre previously conveyed to West, and leaving within the  
above boundary 7.6 acres, more or less.

The above described land is the greater portion of the same conveyed to me by  
Lora M. Davis, et al., on the 11th day of  
February 19 47, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for  
Greenville County, in Book 316 Page 295
