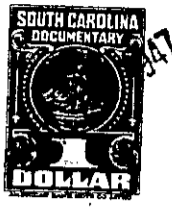

Whereas I, C. M. Ledbetter of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, during 1913 executed & delivered to Rev. H. Haydock for valuable consideration, a deed of conveyance to #504, Section 3 of Graceland Cemetery, Greenville County, State aforesaid; and whereas said deed was unrecorded & subsequently destroyed in a fire; I, the said C. M. Ledbetter do hereby execute the following deed of conveyance in lieu of the original deed:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, C. M. Ledbetter of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred & Five Dollars (\$105.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Rev. H. Haydock (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Rev. H. Haydock, his heirs assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, County, State of South Carolina

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying, being & situate in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, known as #504, Section 3 in Graceland Cemetery, consisting of space for six (6) adult graves.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by on the day of 1941, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for County in Book Page

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Heirs and Assigns forever.
