

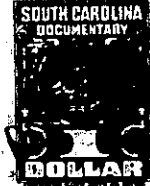

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in

Saluda

Township,

Greenville

County, State of South Carolina

Beginning at a point in the north margin of Highway no 25 the south west corner of that ten acre tract as conveyed by Martha Hawkins to Luther Stanton and running thence with the north margin of said Highway S 33° 30' W 50 feet to a stake thence leaving said highway and running a new line N 62° 40' W 564 feet to a rock in a hollow above the spring thence N 36° E 513 feet to a stake in the original line thence with the original line as follows S 23° 45' E 375 feet to a poplar thence S 15° 30' E 43.5 feet to a small dog wood on a bank of a branch thence down the branch S 21° E 167 feet thence S 75 feet to the Beginning margin on highway 25 — containing 3.9 acres more or less
