presents do grant, bargain, sell and release	unto the said Marvin D. King, his heirs and
assigns, forever:	

All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southeast side of Central Avenue (sometimes known as Briarcliff Drive) near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 29 on Plat of Dixie Heights, made by C. M. Furman, Jr., Engineer, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "H", Page 46, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Central Avenue, joint front corner of Lots 29 and 30, said pin being 200 feet in a Northeasterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Central Avenue intersects with the Northeast side of Argonne Street and running thence with the line of Lot 30, S. 46-48 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence along the rear line of Lot 61, N. 43-12 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot'28, N. 46-48 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Central Avenue, said pin being 232 feet in a Southwesterly direction from the point where the Southeast side of Central Avenue intersects with the Southwest side of Westview Road and running thence along the Southeast side of Contral Avenue, S. 43-12 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to me by deed of W. A. Cox, dated September 16, 1947, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Green-ville County, S. C. in Deed Book 317, Page 196.

The Grantee is to pay 1947 taxes.
