Lindley line 352.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 15-20 W. 509 feet to an iron pin, 26.4 feet from the center of the road; thence N. 15-20 W. 26.4 feet to the center of the said Pelzer Road; thence S. 88-30 E., along the center of the Pelzer Road 360 feet to the point and place of the beginning, containing 3.93 acres, more or less.
