and to construct, maintain and operate in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles,
wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by elec-
tricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said
line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right at all times to cut away
and keep clear of said line all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper main-
tenance and operation of the same. Necessary poles to be located along either
side of said streets for the purpose of supporting trackless trolley
overhead wiring.

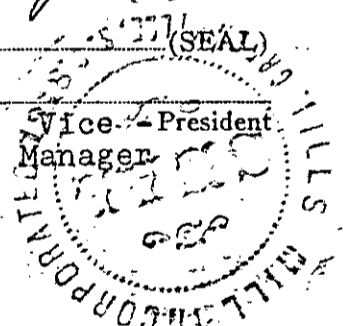
