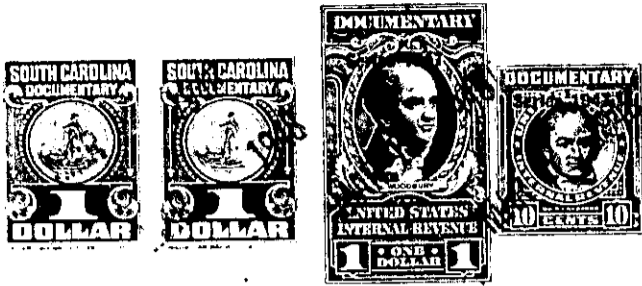

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Greenville** Township, **Greenville**  
County, State of South Carolina, on the Western side of Beatrice Street and known and  
designated as lot No. 62 of Map of Camella Park as shown on a plat recorded  
in Plat Book "G" at page 225 and having the following metes and bounds, to

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Beatrice Street, joint corners of lots Nos.
