It is further agreed, that Mary Ruth L. Campbell shall have all the household furniture which is at present situate in the home of the said parties, 14 Wright Street, American Spinning Company, to do whatever she pleases with said furniture.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, and understood that each of the parties hereto may hereafter live where and in such manner as he or she may so desire without the interference of the other in any manner, during the life of either.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, that this contract can be modified, altered or abrogated only upon the written statements of both of the parties hereto, setting forth in detail such further agreements or alterations.

Should either of the parties hereto move to another state and establish a legal residence therein, and should thereafter institute divorce proceedings, the other party will submit himself or herself to the jurisdiction of that court for the purpose of hearing such action.
