CONVEYANCE

WHEREAS, The Augusta Road Water & Sewer Sub-District of Greenville, South Carolina, is an organized and existing political subdivision and as such a municipal corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, and

WHEREAS, Said District has heretofore acquired certain land easements, rights of way, sewer and water lines and other real and personal properties in connection with its operations, and

WHEREAS, On petition duly filed by a majority of the free-holders within said district, an election was duly held on November 25, 1947 whereby the "Augusta Road Area", including the entire area of Augusta Road Water & Sewer Sub-District, voted to become annexed to and become a part of the City of Green-ville, South Carolina, on the terms and provisions set forth in said petition, and

WHEREAS, The election was also duly carried favorable to the annexation by the voters in the City of Greenville, South Carolina, and the Greenville City Council has duly declared the election as having carried in favor of annexation and has, by proper resolution of the Greenville City Council dated December 1, 1947, annexed the "Augusta Road Area" to the City of Greenville as a part and parcel thereof, and

WHEREAS, Among others, it was provided in the petition and annexation resolution that

"The City of Greenville shall receive and own title to the Augusta Road Water and Sewer Sub-District's present Firefighting equipment together with all properties used and useful in the operation thereof and all water hydrants and service lines heretofore furnished or provided by the petitioning area or the said Augusta Road Water and Sewer District along with all water and sewer lines lying in the streets of said below described area or otherwise located except privately owned lines, and also all rights of way, buildings, equipment and supplies used or useful in connection therewith, together with all easements, public streets and alleys in said area."
