

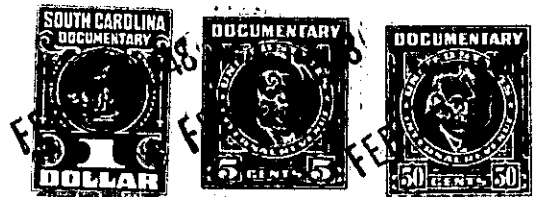

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James D. Rohr

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, near Paris Station being known and designated as Lot 100
according to the plat of Super Highway Home Sites made by Dalton and Neves, May 1946,
and recorded in Plat Book "P", at page 53, subject to building and other restrictions
as set forth in an instrument recorded in Deed Book 291, pages 369 and 370. Said
records are in the Office of Register Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County. Said
lot has the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING on Bob White Lane at corner of Lot 101; thence with Lot 101 N. 32-05 W.
175.8 feet to a five foot strip in the rear reserved for utilities; thence N. 36-20 E.
30 feet to the corner of Lot 136; thence with Lot 136 S. 81-45 E. 183.6 feet to
Meridian Avenue; thence with Meridian Avenue and Bob White Lane Southwesterly
