All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, containing one acre, more or less, being situate at the most westerly corner of my tract of land and also being situate on the north side of the Buncombe Road and on the east or southeast side of a County Road and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake at a culvert, the most westerly corner of my tract of land and running thence with the center line of the County Road, N. 32½ E. 147 feet to a stake; thence still with the center line of said County Road, N. 62 E. 84.5 feet to a stake; thence with my line, S. 46-27 E. 170 feet to a stake; thence with my line, S. 23-38 W. 190 feet to a stake on the north side of the Buncombe Road; thence with said road, N. 57-38 W. 237.9 feet to the beginning.
