

County, State of South Carolina, just off the New Buncombe Road, about three miles from Greenville County Court House, being known and designated as a part of Tract No. 4 of property of Union Central Life Insurance Company on plat made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1937, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance, State and County aforesaid in Plat Book "1", at pages 69 and 70, and being designated as Lot No. one (1) on plat of property of A. S. Campbell, made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, May, 1947, and having as a whole, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
