## CHARTER

BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS.

HAROLD F. GODSHALL, JAMES A. BROWN, JR. and JAMES L. SWINDLER,

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is PIEDMONT VARIETY AND EQUIPMENT COMPANY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is — to conduct a general wholesale and retail mercantile, supply, variety and equipment business and to own, buy and sell real estate.
