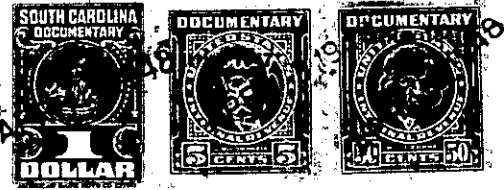

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, on the North side of Edgemont Avenue in a sub-division known  
as Riverside, and being known and designated as lot No. 6 of Block "N", accord-  
ing to a Plat of Riverside prepared by P. H. Foster October 1909, said Plat  
being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A",  
pages 322 and 323, and having according to said Plat, the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Edgemont Avenue, which pin is 104 feet in an Easterly direction from the intersection of Edgemont Avenue and Pickens Street, and running thence N. 10-15 E., 125 feet to a point on a fifteen-foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 79-45 E., 50 feet to a point on said alley, joint corner of lots Nos. 6 and 7; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 10-15 W., 125 feet to a point on the North side of Edgemont Avenue; thence with the North side of Edgemont Avenue, N. 79-45 W., 50 feet to an iron pin, the beginning
