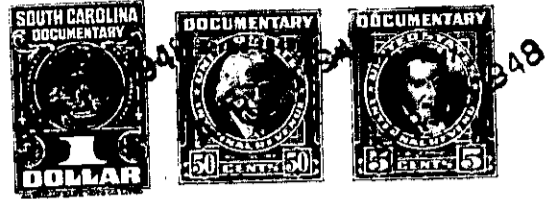

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said L. L. Taylor and Georgia C.
Taylor, and their Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, lying on the South side of the Brushy Creek
Road, near the old limits of the City of Greer, being all of Lot
No. 29, according to plat of property of the Mrs. J. A. Wood Estate
mad by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, June 22, 1935, and having the
following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on joint corner with Lot No. 26 and running a common
line therewith S. 11.56 E. 170 feet to a stake; thence S. 76.2. 70
feet to a stake on the line of Lot No. 30; thence N. 11.56 W. 161.9
feet to a stake on the South side of Brushy Creek Road; thence with
the South side thereof N. 70.19 E. 70.8 feet to the beginning.
