

A. League. That deed is dated June 3, 1947, is recorded in Deed Book 313, Page 88. The land in question is described in the deed from W. C. Cleveland to G. Frank League in the following manner to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on property line of the W. B. McDaniel Estate and W. C. Cleveland, said pin being 496.7 feet due east from the east side of McDaniel Avenue, and running thence along said property line of W. C. Cleveland and the estate of W. B. McDaniel due east 243.3 feet to iron pin; thence with the line of other property of W. C. Cleveland, due north 375.3 feet to an iron pipe on the south side of Park Drive; thence along the south side of Park Drive N. 82-55 W. 212.2 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of other property of the said W. C. Cleveland S. 8-30 W. 208.8 feet to a stake by a beech tree; thence S. 00-21 W. 195 feet to the beginning point, said lot being a part of the property of W. C. Cleveland and known as Cleveland Forest.

This property is subject to a right of way or easement granted by the said W. C. Cleveland to the City of Greenville for the purposes of laying and maintaining a sewer line.

The references hereinabove made to Park Drive refer to the present Woodland Way the name of that street having been changed and the calls given herein are as taken from the original deed from W. C. Cleveland to G. Frank League.
