will be clear of the power line of Duke Power Company which parallels the Western line of property of Piedmont and Northern Railway Company. PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that the said right-of-way shall be reduced in width, if necessary, so that the dwelling now located on or near the proposed roadway shall not be moved to locate a 60 foot roadway, but, when and if the dwelling is torn down or moved the said right-of-way shall thereafter be sixty (60) feet in width at all points.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said right-of-way and the rights and privileges hereinabove granted unto the said Piedmont and Northern Railway Company, its Successors and Assigns, forever:
