

either of them, and in evidence thereof shall discontinue the operation of the same, and take up and remove the rails, materials and fixtures therein, then and in such event the right of way hereby conveyed for such track or tracks so removed, and all rights incident or appurtenant thereto, shall revert to the Grantor, its successors and assigns.
