KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, T. C. STONE; HARRIET N. STONE,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said <u>ALBERTUS C. SPAIN, His Heirs and</u> Assigns, Forever:
All of that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and in the City of Greenville, on the Southern side of Wedgewood Avenue, and being known and designated as Lot No. 8 of Section C, according to plat of Croftstone Acres prepared by C. B. Dawsey, August, 1946, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
wood Avenue at the joint front corner of Lots No. 7 and 8 of Section C which point is located 550.6 feet from the Southeastern intersection of Wedgewood Avenue and Summit Drive, and running thence along the Southern side of Wedgewood Avenue, N. 63-10 £. 80 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 9, and running thence in a Southeasterly direction along the rear lines of Lots No. 9, 10, 11 and 12 256.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 8, 12 and 13; thence in a Westerly direction 62 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots No. 7 and 8; thence along the common line of said last mentioned lots in a Northwesterly direction 224.4 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
