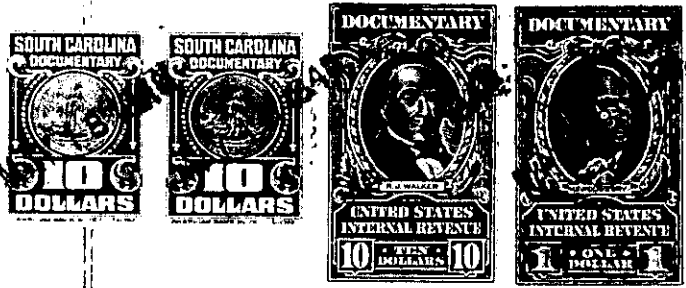

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Harriet M. Stone, as Trustee,
and E. E. Stone

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ninety-Six Hundred Eighty and
No/100 (\$9,680.00) - - - - - Dollars,

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Sears, Roebuck and Co.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said SEARS, ROEBUCK AND CO., its
Successors and Assigns, forever:

All those certain pieces, parcels or lots of land in
the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South
Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 80 and 81,
Section H, as shown on a plat of Stone Land Company, made by
J. E. Sirrine, Engineer, May 21, 1909, and recorded in the R.M.C.
Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 337-347, said
plat having been redrafted and replatted in Plat Book K, page 277,
and having in the aggregate, according to said plats, the follow-
ing metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Miller
Street, joint corner of Lots No. 71 and 80, and running thence
with Miller Street, S. 20-19 W. 92 feet, 11 inches to an iron
pin on the North side of a thirty foot street; thence with said
thirty foot street, N. 84-30 W. 193 feet, 11 inches to an iron
pin joint corner of Lots No. 79 and 81; thence along the line of
Lot No. 79, N. 20-19 E. 135 feet, 8 inches to an iron pin joint
corner of Lots No. 80 and 69; thence with the rear line of Lots
No. 69, 70 and 71, S. 71-50 E. 189 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the same land conveyed to Harriet
M. Stone as Trustee for E. E. Stone by deed of C. R. Stone,
Trustee, dated December 28, 1934, and recorded in the R. M. C.
Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 129 at page 282. This
conveyance is made pursuant to the authority of the Trustee con-
tained in the aforementioned deed to Harriet M. Stone, Trustee
for E. E. Stone and E. E. Stone joins in this conveyance in order
that there shall be no question as to the authority of the Trustee,
the trust having been established for the benefit of E. E. Stone.
