

All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Paris Mountain County, State of South Carolina Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the south side of Sulpher Springs Road and on the West side of Reedy River, and having the following metes and bounds, according to a survey made by G. A. Ellis, April 1st 1940, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of the bridge over Reedy River, which point is the center of Reedy River; and running thence along the center of the Sulpher Springs Road S. 86-30 W. Seven Hundred and Fifty (750) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 11-30 W. three hundred (300) feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 42-30 E four hundred and seventy-three (473) feet to an iron pipe, center of Branch; thence S. 82-30 E. down said branch two hundred and thirty-five (235) feet to an in pin, center of branch; thence S. 7-30 E. three hundred and eighty-five (385) feet to an iron pin in the Blassingame line; thence S. 75-15 E. three hundred and ninety (390) feet to the center of Reedy River; thence up the meanders of said river to the beginning corner about thirteen Hundred (1300) feet, containing seventeen and twenty-five one- hundredths (17.25) acres, more or less, and being the same property conveyed to me by J. R. Webb and Ione G. Webb.
