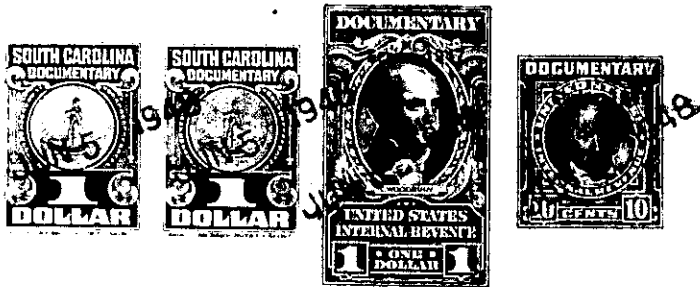

presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. O. Crenshaw and Beatrice  
Crenshaw

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot #1 of the  
Eliza T. Looper property as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton, Dec.  
1924, and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at corner of Looper and Gordon Streets and running  
thence with Gordon Street S. 71-17 W. 51.5 feet to corner of lot #2;  
thence with line of lot #2, N. 16.08 W. 149.8 feet to a point in line  
of lot #61; thence with line of lot #61, N. 71-17 E. 69.4 feet to Looper  
Street; thence with Looper Street S. 9-18 E. 151.8 feet to the beginning  
corner.
