

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Annie West, wife of William G. Gandy, Jr., as executors under the will of W. R. Gandy, deceased, and Eleanor C. Carter in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of fifteen hundred forty-four and no/100 (\$1,544.00) Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by HENRY M. Milesby (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said HENRY M. Milesby, his heirs, executors, successors:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the east side of Bee Street near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known as Lots 17, 18 and 19 of Queen Heights made by W. C. Howell, Jr., and J. P. Moore, November 1944, recorded in the U. S. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in flat Book "O", Rec. 67, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the southeast corner of the intersection of Bee Street and Rack Alley and running thence with the east side of Rack Alley, S. 30-48 E. 130 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lots 13 and 22, S. 21-45 E. 130 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot 20; thence with the line of Lot 20, N. 21-45 E. 130 feet to an iron pin on the east side of Bee Street; thence with the east side of Bee Street, N. 21-45 E. 130 feet to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of the property devised under the will of W. R. Gandy, Jr. means to his daughter, Susan Alice Gandy (now Mrs. H. M. Milesby) during her life and after her death to Eleanor C. Carter, his surviving daughter, who were the only children of the said W. R. Gandy, Jr.; all of which will more fully appear by reference to the will of W. R. Gandy, Jr. means on file in the office of the Probate Court of Greenville County in Apartment 2, Suite 25, 100 Main Street, Greenville, S. C., on December 2, 1947, leaving his will which is on file in the Probate Court in Greenville County, S. C., in the volume and page number 28, wherein he named Annie West, wife of W. R. Gandy, Jr., as executors, giving said executors full power and authority to sell any real estate owned by him, and this instrument is executed by said executors in pursuance of his power and authority given by the said will.
