HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Mack C. Thomas and Elma Lee Thomas, all the right, title and
being an undivided 1/4 interest in and to the following described real estate:
ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land in Saluda Township, Green-
ville County, State of South Carolina, on the branch waters of Tyger River,
being on the right hand side of the road leading from the National Highway
between Greenville and Hendersonville to Tigerville, containing 50 acres,
more or less. It being the intention of J. R. Thompson to convey to Webb
R. Bridgeman all the land on the right hand side of said road as above set
