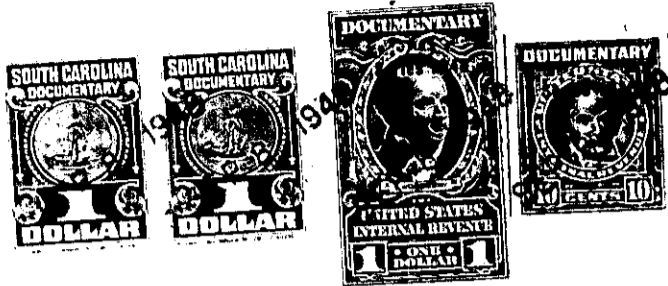

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Fred A. Wilbanks and his

heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Lenoah School, lying on the Gap Creek or Greenville Road, bounded by lands of Homer Fowler, B.J. Odam, Brown, lands formerly owned by B.A. Jenkins, and possibly others, and having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a large poplar, and runs thence N. 26 E. 4.30 chains to a stone; thence N. 26 1/2 W. 7.61 chains to a point in road; thence N. 49 E. 3.56 chains to a point in road; thence S. 27 1/2 E. 7.27 chains to a point in road; thence S. 35 1/4 E. 2.71 chains to a point; thence S. 49 1/2 W. 3.75 chains to a point in the pasture; thence S. 10 W. 5.00 chains to a stake in branch; thence up the branch N. 45 W. 4.30 chains to a stake; thence N. 44 1/2 E. 35 links to the beginning corner, containing Four and 75/100 (4.75) Acres, more or less.
