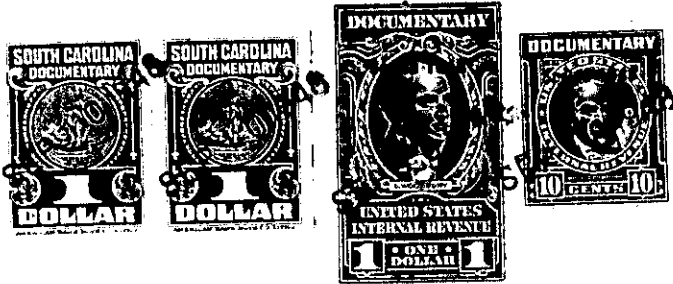

his Heirs and Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, near Paris Station being known and designated as Lot 66
according to the plat of Super Highway Home Sites made by Dalton & Neves, May 1946,
as recorded in Plat Book "P", at page 53, subject to building and other restrictions
as set forth in an instrument recorded in Deed Book 291, pages 300 and 300. Said
records are in the Office of Register Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County.
