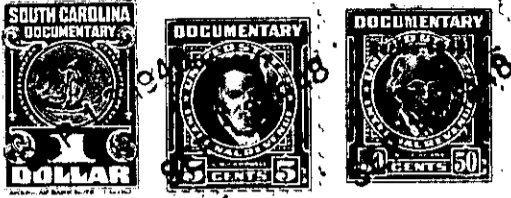

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Bruce Bowen, of the  
County of Greenville,  
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Forty (\$140.00)  
Dollars  
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Cora Cox  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Cora Cox, her heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, BEGINNING at iron pin on Milton Irwin's line,  
and running thence N. 44-50 E. 134 feet to iron pin on Old Paris Mtn.  
Road; thence with said Paris Mountain Road, Seventeen (17) feet to  
Jackson Boulevard; thence up said Jackson Boulevard to Milton Irwin's  
line; thence with Milton Irwin's line, N. 22 W. 16 feet to the begin-  
ning corner; this property is located in what is known as Brewtontown,  
near the City of Greenville, and is the same conveyed to me by E. E.  
Watson by deed dated March 13, 1946, recorded in Vol. 288 at page 425
