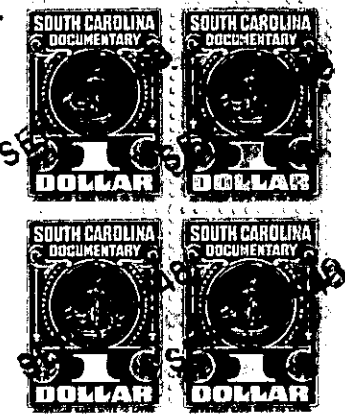
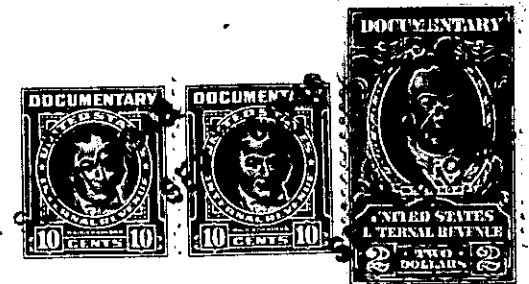

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, Charlie Willis and Marie Willis

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of two thousand (\$2000.00)

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by Aubrey C. Fore
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Aubrey C. Fore and her heirs and
assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, being located on the West side
of a sixteen (16) foot alley, said alley running between Walnut Street and Mauldin
Street, and being known and designated as Lot #121 according to a plat of the pro-
perty of P. R. Long and Walter Goldsmith, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in
May, 1944, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for said County and
State in Plat Book "O" at Page 21, and according to said plat being described as
follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of said alley, joint corner of
Lots #121 and #123 and running thence along said alley N-2-45-W 35 feet to an
iron pin; thence S-87-15-W 75 feet to an iron pin; thence S-2-45-E 35 feet to
an iron pin; thence N-87-15-E 75 feet to the beginning corner.

P. R. Long and Walter W. Goldsmith on the 12th day of
May 19 45, deed recorded in office Register of Mesne Conveyance for
Greenville County, in Book 275 Page 301
