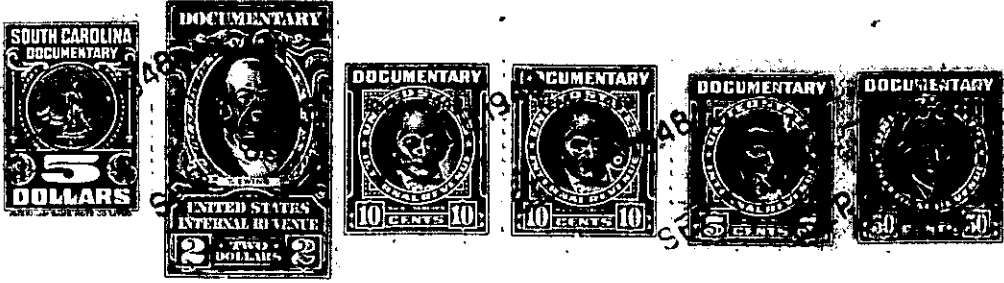

by Trustees, Memorial Methodist Church, Greenville, South Carolina
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Trustees of Memorial Methodist Church

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, being on the West side of West Faris Road and being
shown as Lot no. 6 and a portion of Lot no. 5 of the property of John T.
Davenport on unrecorded plat drawn by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March, 1924;
and more particularly shown on a revision of said plat drawn by Piedmont
Engineering Service on July 23, 1948; and having, according to said plats,
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of West Faris Road, said pin
being 360.6 feet from the South side of Augusta Road, and running thence
N. 69-0 W. 180.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 21-23 W. 100 feet to an iron
pin, joint rear corner of Lots nos. 6 and 7; thence S. 69-0 E. 181.3 feet to
an iron pin on West Faris Road, joint front corner of Lots nos. 6 and 7; thence
N. 21-0 E. 100 feet along West Faris Road to point of beginning.
