Beginning at an iron pin in the center of McCarter's Road, corner of a tract of 33.65 acres as shown on said plat, and running thence with line of said tract of land, N. 90.00 W. 825 feet to a branch; thence along said branch, S. 12-30 E. 126 feet to joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence along the line of Lot No. 2, N. 80-30 E. 786.8 feet to an iron pin on McCarter's Road; thence along the western side of McCarter's Road, 105 feet to the point of beginning.
